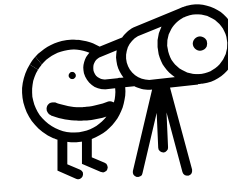


GERMAN—CULTURAL EXPLORATION



Part of your grade is awarded for individual exploration of German language and culture. You will accumulate points by completing various kinds of activities. Please study the following information carefully. These categories will earn points for cultural exploration.

Participate in an International Club or German Club Meeting. --ICC: 2nd Tues., SRT B (1:05) --GC: 2nd Fr., SRT B (1:05)	Choose a German website (see “Resources Page” on fhsgerman.weebly.com) and review it in 100 words (English) for its interest and learning value. CITE SOURCES!	Attend a German cultural event and write a review. (i.e. Play, concert, Restaurant, etc.); 100 Words in English)	Participate in Indiana Staatskongress (February)
Complete a pack of 10 Flash Cards with your hardest words from our current chapter. -- MUST HAVE: Color, hand-drawn picture.	Read a short fiction or non-fiction text in German and write a brief reaction in English (100 Words). (see “Resource” page on fhsgerman.weebly.com website)	Choose a famous German historical event, art movement, or person. Report on this person with Google Slides for class. (5 Slides)	Host a German exchange student.
Watch 3 “Sendung mit der Maus” Episodes --Write a short description of the problem & how Maus solves it. -- German 1: in English -- German 2-AP: auf Deutsch	Watch an episode of “Easy German” (YouTube Channel). Write down the episode Name & Number, at least 5 responses to the question, and how this is similar or different to how Americans would respond.	Teach a family member 10 German words. Then, make up a written vocabulary quiz and have him/her take it. After they take the quiz, write down what techniques you used to teach them. Have your family member sign the quiz and say what they think of your teaching style. TURN EVERYTHING IN.	Teach a parent a German conversation from class. Make a video of you & your parent having this conversation twice: Once with you asking the questions, once with your parent. Have your parent comment on how you taught it, and what they think of your teaching style.
	Make a German Recipe for the class. MUST COME FROM: http://www.german-recipes-and-more.com/ for ideas! (Prepare a PowerPoint about it for a bonus 2pts!)	Complete “German Song Review” with a parent. 	Plan a German Club Meeting Activity (explain/lead a German game, recite a German poem, sing a German song...etc.)	Borrow & watch German film from library/Netflix/YouTube/other. Write a summary & reaction in English. (100 Words)	
	Facebook: Like the page “I like Germany”. Check out the posts and choose several which interest you. Give a written, English description of what you find (100 words).	Listen to a complete music album by a German artist and write a brief summary & reaction to it. Present for a bonus +2pts. (100 Words, English)	
	Find a German news site and write a brief report in English on a current political or social event (100 Words) CITE SOURCES!	Visit the Himmel Haus store in Dunlap (US 33, across from the Concord Mall). Take a Selfie there and write a Short Paragraph describing unique things to be found there and your reaction (100 Words)	
	Complete the “Learn”, “Write”, or “Spell” on activities on one of the Quizlet lists for your current level.	Create a painting, model, or Minecraft model of a real German person or place. Include a plaque with the name, location, and age.	
		Learn & Perform a German song or poem. (Approval by Herr Gigler required)
